The Odstock Wedge reduces pressure under the heels without increasing pressure on the thighs and calves. 



#### **CLEANING OF INVACARE PRODUCTS**

**GENERAL CLEANING** – to prevent delamination, use a solution of neutral detergent and hot water, or alternatively a 0.1% chloride solution. Apply with single use wipe. Following application, the cover should be rinsed with clean water (damp cloth) and **thoroughly** dried.

Removable contaminated covers should be laundered at 80°C with a dilute detergent solution. Please ensure covers are thoroughly rinsed and dried before placing back on the Invacare product.

(Invacare recommends that nursing staff should always actively liase with a qualified Infection Control Nurse regarding decontamination protocols.)
